## A PROCLAMATION

FOR A DAY OF

## PUBLIC THANKSGIVING AND PRAISE.

By advice and consent of the Council, I have appointed, and do hereby appoint, Chursday, the twenty-ninth day of November next, a Day of Chanksgibing: and I invited the People of the Commonwealth to observe this day, already set apart by the principal States of the Union for the same Christian purpose, after the high spirit and solemn manner of our fathers, by Public Thanksgiving and Praise to Almighty God, for the innumerable blefsings that surround and support us:

Especially for the inestimable privileges of Republican Institutions of Government, under which the Deople suffer chiefly from their own errors, and are permitted opportunities to correct them: in which tradition does not entail upon the future the wrongs of the past, and authority has no power to supprefs the demands of public justice:

For the favored position which separates our beloved country from the political complications that torture other nations, and secures to us well regulated. Liberty and universal Deace:

For the preservation of the States united :

For the wich harvests of the year :

For the privileges of general education :

For the capacity and hope of future improvement,
