## A PROCLAMATION.



HAVING pleased Almighty GOD to give the most remarkable Success to His Majesty's Arms this Year in *America*, more particularly in the Reduction of *Quebeck* (the Capital of *Canada*) and the adjacent Country;

I HAVE therefore thought fit, with the Advice of His Majesty's Council, to issue this Proclamation, appointing Thursday the Twenty-fifth Day of *October* Instant, to be observed as a Day of Public Thanksgiving throughout this Province, to commemorate these distinguishing Instances of the Divine Goodness ----- Hereby recommending it to Ministers and People to unite in their respective Churches and Congregations, in rendering to Almighty GOD their grateful Praises for these undeserved Favours; and in presenting their humble Prayers and Supplications for His most gracious Majesty King *GEORGE*, the Prince of *Wales*, and the rest of the Royal Family; and for the Continuance of the Divine Blessing upon His Majesty's Government, and upon His Arms.

*GIVEN* at the Council-Chamber in Boston the Thirteenth Day of October, 1759, in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord *GEORGE* the Second, by the Grace of *GOD*, of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c.
